## MARTLET RUN

### SUNDAY 24<sup>th</sup> April 2022

A classic motorcycle charity event for all 2 & 3-wheeled vehicles irrespective of age, so any motorcycle is more than welcome. This year the club continues to support Kamelia Kids Childrens' Charity near Worthing which helps and educates young children with learning difficulties and disabilities. The Martlet Run was formerly the Engineerium Run until the pumping works ceased to be available to us. The 'Martlet' is an heraldic and mythical bird adopted as Sussex's coat of arms at the beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, but is thought to originate from earlier times.

Start and finish of the run will be from the club house at Clymping Sports and Social club located one mile west of Littlehampton on the A259. Registration will be from 9.00am and the runs departures start from 10.00am. The event will entail following a marked route with accompanying route card and map for approximately 65 miles, but there is an alternative shorter route available of 35 miles. At the finish there will be concours judging 1.30-2.30pm with awards presented immediately after the judging. There will be 3 awards. Best in show. Best pre-1960. Best post-1960. Riders are respectfully asked to return to Clymping and support the full event and this awards ceremony.

Pre-booked early bird entries on or before Saturday 1st April is £12 per rider and £5 for a passenger but modern bikes from year 2000 onwards the registration fee will be £14 per rider and £5 per passenger. Later entries and entries on the day will be accepted (subject to availability) at £15 and £5 per passenger. Hot food, tea or coffee will be available at the start and finish and a complimentary one bacon roll and tea/coffee and event badge is included in the pack. Entry fees are non-refundable. Route cards and riding number will be given to you on the day.
