## MARTLET RUN

(All proceeds go to Charity)

### SUNDAY 28<sup>th</sup> April 2024

A classic motorcycle charity event for all 2 & 3-wheeled vehicles irrespective of age, so any motorcycle is more than welcome. This year the club continues to support Kamelia Kids Childrens' Charity near Worthing which helps and educates young children with learning difficulties and disabilities. The Martlet Run was formerly the Engineerium Run until the pumping works ceased to be available to us. The 'Martlet' is a heraldic and mythical bird adopted as Sussex's coat of arms at the beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, but is believed to originate from earlier times.

Start and finish will be from the club house at Climping Sports and Social club, located one mile west of Littlehampton on the A259 (BN175SN). Registration is from 9-00am and runs departure start from 10.00am. The event will entail following a route-card map for approximately 50 miles around the best local roads although we do hope to have a sufficient number of group leaders for those who are map challenged and prefer to follow someone. There will be lucky draw prizes 1.30-2 pm as we have found many participants who think they stand little chance of winning a 'best of' award rarely returning to the club house at the end of the run. So shiny and not-so shiny now stand an equal chance of winning prizes.

Pre-booked early bird entries 10 days before the event date are £12 per rider and £5 per passenger but modern bikes from the year 2000 onwards the fee will be £14 per rider and £5 per passenger. Later entries or on the day entries will be accepted, subject to availability, at a fee of £15 and £5 per passenger. Hot food, tea and coffee will be available at the start and finish times and one complimentary bacon roll +tea/coffee voucher and an event badge will be included in your pack. Entry fees are non-refundable. Route card and riding number will be given to you on the day.
